LARNACH TO BEGIN SEASON WITH MIRACLE

Former College World Series hero set for High-A debut

FORT MYERS, Fla. – The Minnesota Twins have announced that last year’s first round pick, Trevor Larnach, will begin the 2019 season with the Fort Myers Miracle, their Class-A Advanced affiliate in the Florida State League.

Larnach, selected with the 20th overall pick, is the first collegiate outfielder drafted in the first round by the Twins since Paul Powell in 1969.

The former Oregon State product led the Beavers to the 2018 College World Series title. Larnach hit .417 with five doubles in eight games at the College World Series. He drilled a two-run home run in the ninth inning of an eventual game two win over Arkansas to help Oregon State stave off elimination. The Beavers would go on to take game three to win their third NCAA Championship and first since 2007.

Larnach began his professional career with the Rookie-level Elizabethton Twins of the Appalachian League on July 18. In 18 games, Larnach hit .311 with two home runs and 16 RBI. He was promoted to Class-A Cedar Rapids on August 7 and finished the year with the Kernels, where he hit .297 with three home runs and 10 RBI in 24 games.

The defending Florida State League Champion Miracle open the 2019 season on Thursday, April 4 at Hammond Stadium against the Charlotte Stone Crabs. First pitch is scheduled for 6:30 p.m.
