DIAZ NAMED MINNESOTA TWINS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Miracle first baseman rewarded for historic performance in Bradenton

FORT MYERS, Fla. – Lewin Diaz has been named the Minnesota Twins Player of the Week for the week of May 11-17. During that span, the Miracle first baseman went 9-for-23 (.391) with three home runs and six RBI.

On May 16, Diaz etched his name into the Miracle record books by becoming the first player in franchise history to hit three home runs in a single game. Diaz went deep in the third, fifth, and seventh innings to help the Miracle to a 13-7 win over the Bradenton Marauders.

After failing to hit a home run in April, the Miracle first baseman has homered seven times in 15 May games. Diaz is two home runs shy of tying the franchise mark for most home runs in a single month. Both Miguel Sano (April 2013) and Matthew LeCroy (August 1998) homered nine times in a calendar month.

In 2018, Diaz hit six homers in 79 games before missing the final six weeks of the season with a broken thumb.
